

Introducing KODAK Systems Contrast Test Service

KODAK Systems Contrast Test Service allows an individual lab to compare the print-through contrast of a direct print to the print-through contrast of a release print produced from a duplicate negative.

Benefits: This test lets you confirm that the sensitometric image quality you obtain when printing an original negative to a direct print will match that of a release print using KODAK Color Intermediate Film and KODAK Color Print Film. Additionally, the results from this test let you identify any contrast mismatch, if applicable, that may be associated with either your printer and/or printing methods.

Deliverables: Kodak will provide a written report within five working days after receiving the processed samples. The report will include a sensitometric comparison of the direct and release prints, as originated from KODAK Color Negative Film. The report will also include sensitometric process control curves of the individual lab against our in-house Kodak laboratory, for both the interpositive and duplicate negative processing events. These comparisons will be made on KODAK Color Intermediate Film. Recommendations for possible corrective action will be made if needed.
